




















### 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

The City of Waseca celebrated its Sesquicentennial, 150 years of rich history, in conjunction with the Waseca All School Reunion celebration.


We welcomed many visitors into our museum over the busy fun filled weekend.
















The Bailey House received two new windows and a new coat of paint on the west exterior wall.

The above question is one of importance when seeking support from our members and the public at large.


Public accountability and transparency is reflected in
